Ordinance No. 2025-13 – An Emergency Ordinance Levying an Additional Tax on Income at the Rate of One-Half of One Percent in Addition to the One Percent Currently Being Levied and Collected Requiring the Filing of Returns and Furnishing of Information; Imposing on Employers the Duties of Collecting the Tax at the Source and Paying the Same to the City of St. Marys; Providing for the Administration, Collection, and Enforcement of Said Tax; Declaring Violation Thereof to be a Misdemeanor and Imposing Penalties Therefore

Ordinance No. 2025-14 – An Emergency Ordinance Providing for the Issuance and Sale of Bonds in the Maximum Principal Amount of \$2,200.00 for the Purpose of Paying the Property Owners' Portion, in Anticipation of the Collection of Special Assessments of the Costs of the East Spring Street Reconstruction Project Phase 3, by Constructing Curbs, Gutters, Sidewalks, Combination Sidewalks and Curbs, Drive Approaches, Asphalt Pavement and the Repair Thereof, Together With the Necessary Related Improvements and Appurtenances Thereto, and Declaring an Emergency
