Business:

The committee met and reviewed eleven supplemental requests in the amount of \$570,202.77.

Annual contract for Engineering plot wave equipment for \$5,000.

Gas utilities for the old municipal building of \$3,000.

Additional \$580 for services of Millers Textiles for floor mats in the Municipal Building.

Cleaning service budget of \$37,000. Some of this amount will be offset through Alvada due to the construction delay.

Utilizing \$10,641.98 from the FBI-NWOSS Task Force for aiming system police guns.

Real Estate Taxes of \$12,255.04 for City parcels that are income generated properties.

Purchase of a digger truck for the Electric Department in amount of \$355,661.

An additional \$20,000 needed that was not included in the retirement payout from recycling wages and Medicare.

The State did not fully fund grant money for a new recycling truck. Purchase of a truck for \$74,401.92 will provide a new truck and will then have a backup truck as well.

New commercial refuse truck for \$48.662.83.

Street opening refunds for \$3,000.
