

2024 HOLIDAY REFUSE SCHEDULE

Presidents Day February 19 th	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday delayed one day, Friday on regular day.
Memorial Day May 27 th	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday delayed one day, Friday on regular day.
Fourth of July July 4 th	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday on regular day, Thursday delayed one day.
Labor Day September 2 nd	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday delayed one day, Friday on regular day.
Thanksgiving November 28 th	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday on regular day, Thursday delayed one day.
Christmas December 25 th	Monday, Tuesday and Friday regular day, Wednesday and Thursday delayed one day.
New Years Day January 1, 2025	Monday, Tuesday and Friday regular day, Wednesday and Thursday delayed one day.

REFUSE TAG INSTRUCTIONS

Below are rules and regulations regarding refuse pickup with the use of the bag tags.

All trash must be bagged and tied shut. No loose trash will be taken. If refuse is not tagged properly it will not be picked up. Once the refuse is properly tagged it will be picked up on the next regularly scheduled day. There will be no call backs for improperly tagged trash.

Maximum bag size: 33 gallons Maximum bag weight: approximately 33 pounds

Maximum can size: 32 gallons Maximum can weight: approximately 33 pounds

Any container larger than 32 gallons will not be emptied.

Please Note: Nothing should stick out of can; level with top is maximum allowed per can. When in doubt, place another tag on it.

If trash is overflowing the can, it will not be picked up. For example, if the can lid will not fit on the can, it is overflowing.

Put tag around neck of tied bag, NOT flat on bag. If using a garbage can, please place tag on the can handle to be easily torn off. If tag is missing when crew is there, it will not be collected.

Have properly tagged refuse set out for pickup by 7:00 a.m. on pickup day.

Refuse only. No grass, leaves, or ashes.

Corrugated cardboard can be taken to the recycling center located at 15502 River Road or can be picked up with the trash if it is boxed or bundled. A refuse tag must be placed on the box or bundle to be picked up.

Refuse tags can be purchased at Certified Gas Stations, Kroger, Marathon, Pantry Pride, Pump-n-Pack, Sunoco Gas Station, and the City Utility Office.
