

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-10

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A
DAMAGED TRANSFORMER PREVIOUSLY LOCATED AT THE
SPOKEWORKS SUBSTATION**

WHEREAS, the City of St. Marys operates a Municipal Electric System; and,

WHEREAS, a transformer located at the Spokeworks Substation failed and is in the process of being replaced; and,

WHEREAS, the City of St. Marys may receive more for selling the transformer rather than receiving its value in scrap.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service and Safety or his designees are authorized to sell the damaged transformer previously located at the Spokeworks Substation for the amount of \$10,000.00 to T & R Electric Supply Company, Inc. of Colman, South Dakota (hereinafter T & R Electric).

SECTION 2. That this is an emergency ordinance. The reason for the emergency is that the purchase of the replacement transformer is necessary for the continued efficient operation of the St. Marys Municipal Electric System all of which is necessary for the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of St. Marys; therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
